CLASSES

Ages based on 1st day of classes: September 8, 2025

Baby Combo (Ages 18 months - 2 years)

On the fast track to being a Broadway Baby! This 45 min class is an enchanting and delightful introduction to ballet and tap for 18 months- 2 year old children. Basic elements of ballet and tap are introduced through play and instruction using props. This is a magical way for children who love music and movement to channel that energy toward dance. NOTE: The only requirement for participation in Baby Combo is that the student will separate from the parent and follow the general loose structure of the class.

Tiny Combo (ages 3 - 4)

These dancers are tutu cute! This hour class is divided into 30 min sections of ballet and tap. Students will learn the basic building blocks of ballet and tap in a nurturing and child friendly environment. Learning paired with games, activities and props make class more enjoyable and students are more excited to learn.

Tiny Tumbling (ages 3 - 4)

Throughout this 45 minute class, your child will be introduced to a variety of age-appropriate tumbling exercises and skills. They will learn to roll, balance, and explore different body movements in a playful and structured manner. Our instructors utilize colorful mats, props, and soft equipment to create a stimulating environment that encourages curiosity and engagement.

****Tiny Tumbling classes do not have a recital commitment.***

Mini Combo I | Ballet & Tap (ages 5 - 6)

Raising the barre... This hour class is divided into 30 minute sections of ballet and tap. Students build on the basic steps learned in Tiny Combo and move away from as many props and games. The barre is introduced and used for warm-ups in ballet. Students take a closer look at technique and begin learning more complex moves and combinations.

Mini Combo II | Jazz & Hip Hop (ages 5 - 6)

Grooving to the rhythm... This hour-long class is split into 30-minute sessions of jazz and hip hop. The jazz segment emphasizes dynamic movement and fluidity, while the hip hop portion introduces students to street dance fundamentals. This class hones technique and encourages creativity, guiding students through more sophisticated moves and combinations.

Petite Combo (ages 7 - 9)

Petite combo is a captivating ballet, tap, and jazz combo class designed to ignite the passion for dance in young dancers aged 7 to 9. This 2 hour class will take your child on an exploration of classical ballet techniques and the vibrant energy of jazz and tap. This class will perform 2 dances in the recital.

Ballet | Levels offered: Ballet II, Ballet III

This class is the foundation for ballet training and focuses on developing a solid ballet technique with emphasis on understanding correct body placement and terminology.

Tap | Tap II

This class is designed to develop rhythm, style and sound. Students will learn the fundamentals of tap while strengthening their coordination.

Jazz | Jazz II

This class will focus on learning proper jazz dance techniques such as isolations of the body, improving performance quality and developing complex rhythms and patterns. Dancers will learn leaps, turns, and across the floor combinations.

Technique | Competition Program- Audition Required

Technique classes are for the serious dancers looking to take their training to the next level. This class will focus on stretching, leaps, turns, and across the floor combinations to strengthen technique. This class is required for competition team members.

Lyrical | Levels offered: Petite, Lyrical II, Lyrical III

This class will combine elements of both ballet and jazz techniques. This class will teach young dancers to tell a story through their movement. Lyrical focuses on emotion and expression while moving gracefully.

Hip Hop | Levels offered: Petite, Hip Hop II

This high energy dance class is a fun and energetic style of street dance. This style of dance is what you typically see in concerts and music videos. Hip hop will focus on body isolations, footwork, and freestyling.

Acro | Levels offered: Acro I, Acro II

Acro combines elements of dance and acrobatics. Students work on building strength, flexibility, and coordination. Students learn the appropriate progression of tricks, working on tumbling, limbering, and balancing. There is an emphasis on goal setting and building

confidence as students learn handstands, cartwheels, walkovers, and more.

***Acro classes do not have a recital commitment.**

TUITION & ADDITIONAL COSTS

Our full season program runs from September-June with our annual recital in June. Tuition is paid in ten installments billed monthly due on the 1st of each month. Tuition can be paid by cash, check, or credit card. After a 3 day grace period late tuition payments will incur late fees.

RECITAL

- Our annual recital is where dancers showcase what they have learned throughout the season. If your dancer is not participating in the recital, this needs to be communicated to the studio via email no later than November 1st.
- With the exception of Petite Combo and Acro/Tumbling each class will perform one dance in the recital. Petite Combo will perform 2 dances. Acro/Tumbling classes do not have a recital commitment.
- Each costume costs \$80 and will include a garment bag, accessories and a pair of recital tights. This cost will also include any embellishments that may be added to costumes/dances. Ex: Rhinestones or props.
- A \$50 per family media fee is due January 1st. This fee includes a digital download of the recital, access to professional recital photos, and a commemorative t-shirt that dancers will wear in the finale.
- Dancers do not need tickets to the recital but all audience members will need to purchase recital tickets.
- Dancers are expected to arrive on time and ready for both dress rehearsal and recital.

STUDIO POLICIES

It is important that we maintain an environment that allows all dancers to learn and grow while respecting dance etiquette.

- Dancers are expected to arrive on time to class to ensure a proper warm up and prevent injury.
- Regular attendance is expected. If your dancer will be missing class please report their absence in your parent portal account.
- Students are expected to treat both faculty and other students with respect.
- Understand that corrections made by the teacher are constructive and are meant to help dancers improve.
- Parents are expected to drop students off, and pick them up. If not possible, parents are expected to wait in the lobby.
- Parents are not permitted in studio space. We have cameras in the lobby for those who wish to view class. While we strive to provide a seamless viewing experience, we want to acknowledge that our camera system relies on Wi-Fi connectivity, which may not always be perfect. Occasionally, you may experience disruptions or buffering during the live stream.
- Bullying of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Our studio is a drama free environment and any student or parent who disrupts this may be asked to leave our program.

TUITION & REGISTRATION

- A \$35 registration fee (\$45 per family if multiple students or enrolling after November 1st) is required to register each year. All registration fees must be paid in full at the time of registration and are non-refundable. Registration is not complete until the registration fee and first month's tuition are paid in full.
- Tuition is paid in ten installments that are due the 1st of each month from September-June. Tuition rates are based on the full year's tuition divided into equal monthly payments. Although some months have more classes than others the tuition remains the same for each month.

Tuition will be posted to your parent portal account on the 20th of each month and is due on the 1st. After a 3 day grace period, late tuition payments will incur late fees.

- To ensure payments are received on time, we require that all accounts leave a credit card on file with us. If a balance is not paid by the set due date, the card on file will be charged for that amount.
- Premiere Dance Center has the right to cancel a class due to under enrollment. In the event your class is canceled, you will be recommended to another class. If you cannot attend the recommended class you will be refunded for unused tuition.
- Dancers are committed to the class that they signed up for at the beginning of the year. Once enrolled in a class time/day and recital costumes have been ordered dancers are not permitted to switch to another class time/day.
- Tuition will not be refunded for missed classes.
- There is a \$50 cancellation fee if [withdrawing](#) from class prior to the end of the season. If your recital costume(s) was paid in full you may pick it up within two weeks of withdrawal. After two weeks costumes are property of Premiere Dance Center.
- Holidays and other studio closures are already calculated into tuition payments. Cancellations for weather or any other unforeseen circumstances are not included. If you would like to schedule a makeup class for weather related cancellations please email the studio and you will be recommended a similar class to take. Makeup classes must be within 2 weeks of the canceled class.
- Failure to submit timely payments will result in students being dismissed from class. Premiere Dance Center reserves the right to turn over any delinquent accounts to collection agencies and the parent/guardian will be responsible for all additional costs incurred.

DRESS CODE

- Students are required to be in proper dress code for all classes. Proper dance clothing is necessary so that teachers can accurately see the dancers' body positions and movement in order to give necessary corrections. This is important for the dancer's education as well as injury prevention.
- **All hair must be pulled back for dance class, no jewelry permitted (stud earrings allowed)**

Please note dancers are not permitted to change between dance classes. On days where dancers attend ballet a leotard and tights are required- dancers can wear shorts or leggings over their leotard for other classes.

BABY COMBO: leotard, tights, pink leather ballet shoes, tan tap shoes, hair pulled back

TINY COMBO: leotard, tights, pink leather ballet shoes, tan tap shoes, hair pulled back

TINY TUMBLING: leotard or form fitting athletic clothing (**no t-shirts please**), bare feet, hair pulled back

MINI COMBO I: leotard, tights, pink leather ballet shoes, tan tap shoes, hair pulled back

MINI COMBO II: leotard, tan tights, optional leggings or shorts over leotard, tan jazz shoes, white hip hop sneakers

PETITE COMBO: leotard, tights, pink canvas ballet shoes, tan jazz shoes, black lace up tap shoes, hair pulled back

BALLET: leotard, pink tights, ballet skirt optional, pink canvas ballet shoes, hair in a bun

ACRO: leotard or form fitting athletic clothes (**no t-shirts please**), bare feet, hair pulled back

JAZZ: leotard, tights, tan jazz shoes, optional leggings or shorts over leotard, hair pulled back

TAP: leotard, tights, black tap shoes, optional leggings or shorts over leotard, hair pulled back

LYRICAL: leotard, tights, bare feet, optional leggings or shorts over leotard, hair pulled back

TECHNIQUE: form fitting athletic clothing (leotard and tights, leggings and sports bra or tank tops, etc), no baggy street clothing permitted, bare feet, hair pulled back

HIP HOP: form fitting athletic clothing (leotard, leggings and sports bra or tank tops, etc), white hip hop sneakers

BOYS: form fitting athletic clothing, black ballet and tap shoes (if applicable)
